

PENTECOST SUNDAY MAY 15, 2016

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:



"Pentecost" is a Greek word that means "fifty days." It originally referred to a religious feast observe fifty days after Passover, on which the Jews thanked God for the wheat harvest. Today, Christians celebrate Pentecost fifty days after Easter to commemorate the day God sent the Holy Spirit to the early

Church.

In today's Gospel, "Peace" is the first word the resurrected Jesus says to the apostles, a word the Jews used in everyday speech as both a greeting and a farewell. Jesus then shows them his hands and his side to prove that it really was him. He is truly alive!

During this post-resurrection appearance, Jesus tells his disciples he is sending them out on a mission just as his Father sent him on one. Then he breathes on them and tells them he is giving them the Holy Spirit so they can go out and bring forgiveness to all people.

The word "apostle" comes from a Greek word that means "one who is sent." In today's reading, Jesus and the apostles to tell the world about the forgiveness of sins made possible through his death and resurrection.

Breathing on the apostles like Jesus did may seem a bit crude but this action had much religious significance. In the book of Genesis, we read that God gave life to the first man by breathing into his nostrils (2:7) and in the book of Ezekiel (37:1-14) the prophet describes a dream he had in which a valley of dry bones comes to life with the breath of God. Because Scripture closely associates God's breath with new life, we see Jesus' actions in today's Gospel as giving new life to the Church by breathing the Holy Spirit into it.

Finally, today's reading is the closest the four Gospels come to describing the arrival of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. We are accustomed to hearing about the strong wind and the tongues of fire appearing while the apostles and friends of Jesus gathered in prayer, a story we find not in the Gospels but of the Acts of the Apostles. Matthew, Mark, and Luke all end their Gospels with Jesus promising he would soon send the Holy Spirit but only John, in today's reading, gives us an account of the Spirit actually arriving. However, since John story is so simple and uneventful, we often overlook it.

How was the Holy Spirit working through us when we are with our family, our friends, or while we're at work? Pray this week that we will become more aware of how the spirit is working in our daily lives.

I hope that you were able to notice that St. Benedict parish was referenced numerous times in the most recent edition of *The Catholic Voice*, the newspaper for the Diocese of Oakland. I'm grateful to God for the work that this parish has done to be a witness for Christ within our East Oakland community. I'm continually grateful for the hard work and dedication of Father Jay Matthews and the St. Benedict family for building and sustaining this very unique and blessed parish throughout the years. May we continue to work together to build the reign of God and be a catalyst for healing and peace to our neighborhood and beyond.

The *National Catholic Reporter*, the nation's largest independent Catholic newspaper, reported in yesterday's on-line edition that Pope Francis is establishing a commission to explore the possibility of ordaining women as deacons. Citing considerable evidence of women deacons in the early church, the commission will eventually make a recommendation to Pope Francis as to the viability of such a move. I find this prospect very exciting! The Holy Spirit is indeed at work in the highest levels of the church!

I will be away from this Monday, May 16 to Thursday, May 19, for a meeting of the Region Eleven Conference of Presbyteral Senates (RECOPS). This is a group that represents and advocates for the interests of priests in the dioceses of California, Nevada and Hawai'i. I have been a member of this group for over 16 years, and led it for five years. We will be meeting at the Peppermill Hotel in Reno. Don't worry - since I am not a gambler, I won't run myself broke. But meals and dining - that's another story...
