FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:



Today's Gospel from Luke recounts the story of how Jesus satisfies the hunger of a large multitude with just a few fish and a few loaves of bread. Focusing on the great number of people Jesus fed, we often overlook another significant detail. Before giving the food to the people to eat, Jesus raised his eyes to heaven and pronounced a blessing on it (Jesus said grace). This blessing was a very important part of every Jewish meal because a pious Jew would not dare eat without first giving thanks to God gives us all good things.

Although God does not need our thanks, giving God thanks before we eat is a very appropriate response for all that God has given us. Recall how we feel when we give something to someone and we're not acknowledged for the gift. This disappointment is bad enough when the recipient is a stranger or someone you do not know very well but it is much more acute when the person is someone you love. In such a case, because the gift is an expression of your love, it is easy to feel it is your love, not the gift, that the person does not appreciate.

With this in mind, we can really understand how God feels when we fail to give thanks to God for all the gifts that God has so generously bestowed on us. Because of God's great love for us, the pain and the disappointment God feels when we are ungrateful could be hurtful. Our thoughtlessness can only communicate to God how little we value God's many expressions of love.

Today, on the Feast of Corpus Christi (which is Latin for "Body of Christ"), we celebrate and give thanks to God for the gift of the Body and Blood of his son, Jesus. Since the days of the early Church, Christians have understood the story in today's Gospel to be symbolic of the celebration of the Eucharist. Scripture scholars believe this is the main reason why it is the only story we find in all four of the Gospels.

The greatest gift God could have given us is the gift of Jesus, the Son. Because of God's immense love for us, God continues to give us this gift in the form of bread and wine. We take time today to thank God in the special way for this great gift, the gift of his love.

Some people who say grace before meals at home will not do so at a restaurant, are

you OK about seeing grace in a public place?

This weekend our nation honors those who paid the ultimate sacrifice in service to our nation. For many, this Memorial Day holiday marks the unofficial beginning of summer, and this weekend festivities are marked by backyard barbecues and picnics, as well as sales and bargains. All of these activities are a part of our culture's response to this particular holiday, but incorporating a measure of the commemorative, in the midst of the celebration, would be most appropriate. So enjoy, but also pause and remember.

Joining us this weekend at our 11:00 AM liturgy will be Father Sylvester Odurinde, currently in residence at St. Lawrence O'Toole - St. Cyril parish in Oakland, and a recent graduate of St. Mary's College in Moraga. Fr. Sylvester will be in residence here at St. Benedict beginning this August, after returning to his native Nigeria for the summer. He will be moving his things into Fr. Burt's room in early June. Please extend our warm St. Benedict welcome to him as he continues his education for the next year. Fr. Paul will continue to assist us here at St. Benedict as well.
